MURAL PAINTING FEATURE OF NEW THEATER MOTIF

Featured in the decorative motif of the new Los Angeles Theater which will open with the world premiere of Charlie Chaplin in "City Lights" on the 30th inst., is a mural painting executed by A. B. Heinsbergen, said to be the most beautiful and costly ever used in a theater.

Rising from the architectural arrangement for the ceiling and creating an impressive effect of height by skillful application of the principles of perspective in design and color, the figures of the central panel of the mural are those of the three Fates spinning the destinies of man. Above them, bearing the amphora, symbol of the

blessing of grain, soars Father Time on outstretched wings, while cupids in the gayety of music, dance and song make up the background. Featuring four smaller figure groups in rich color, and separated from the main central group by an architectural composition, are four smaller murals. In these groups the figures of the five Muses, Venus and Cupid, Bacchus and the Angel of Peace are seen.

Carried out in the design of the Heinsbergen mural is the French renaissance motif which is featured throughout the Los Angeles.

Charlie Chaplin's newest stellar vehicle, "City Lights," will have its world premiere coincident with the opening of the Los Angeles.
