

Faribault Building Project Under Way

Faribault, Minn., May 25.—Construction of the theater and office building destroyed here recently by fire has been started by William Glaser, owner of the property, at an estimated cost of \$100,000. The structure, to be two stories high, of brick and concrete, has been leased to the Finkelstein & Rueben theater circuit of Minneapolis. Plans were prepared by Liebenberg & Kaplan, Minneapolis architects, while W. K. Robertson, Minneapolis, is the mechanical engineer in charge of construction.
