

# **AN EDINBURGH PLASTERER SUES FOR DAMAGES.**

An action was commenced ago raised in Edinburgh Sheriff Court by George King, plasterer, 117 High Street, against Stuart's Grandolithic Paving Company (Limited), for £500 damages or, under the Employers' Liability Act, £200. The pursuer avers that on 23d February last, while working in the employment of the defenders at the new premises of Messrs Charles Jenner, Princes Street, he stumbled in the dark over a log of wood and fell into the well of a lift. His injuries were so serious that he was unconscious for six weeks and is still under medical treatment. The defenders reply that the accident was caused, or at all events materially contributed to, by the pursuer's own neglect. To-day Sheriff Rutherford closed the record and sent the case to the debate-roll.
