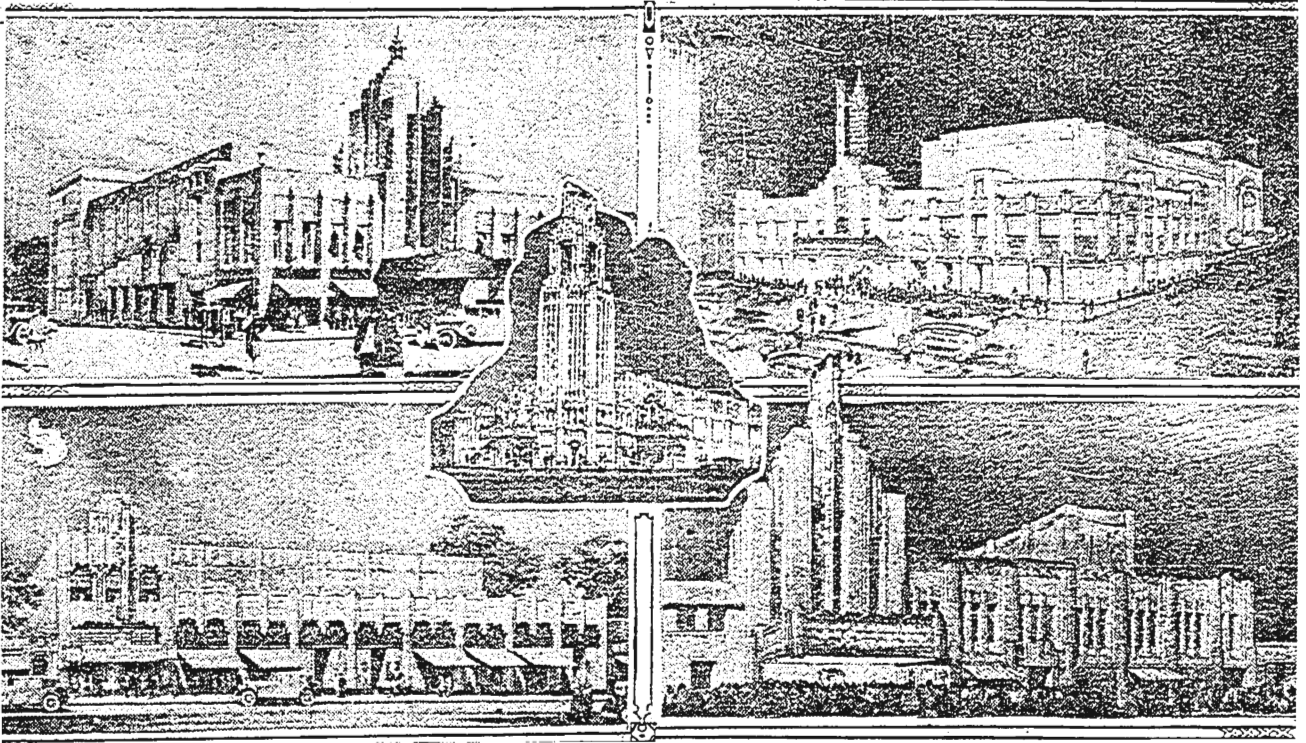


# Showhouse Construction Takes Advantage of Low Costs



Designs for Various Cities Shown

To the upper left is depicted the Warner Brothers Theater at Wilshire Boulevard and Reeves Drive in Beverly Hills, to be started this month. To its right is shown the Fox Pantages Theater at Hollywood Boulevard and Argyle, the opening date for which has been set for the 29th inst. To the lower left is the Fox Theater soon to be built on Greenleaf avenue, Whittier, while Warners' San Pedro project is pictured at the lower right. In the center is the Fox Wilshire Theater now being erected at Wilshire Boulevard and Hamilton, Beverly Hills. Completion is scheduled for September.

## THEATER WORK PLANNED

*Many Fox and Warner Projects Either Under Way  
or Scheduled to Be Started This Summer.*

Theatrical men of the Southland, cognizant of low building costs, are rushing to completion many theater projects, some of which are already under way and others scheduled to be started as soon as plans may be completed.

Included among theater projects scheduled to be built this year are the following total cost of which approximate \$4,750,000:

South Broadway theater for William Fox, which with store building portion is to cost \$1,500,000. Plans are being prepared by Architects S. Tilden Norton, S. Charles Lee and Frederick H. Walls. Construction is scheduled to start in June.

Wilshire and Western theater for Warner Brothers, which with store building portion is estimated to cost approximately \$1,000,000. Plans are being prepared by Architects Morgan, Walls and Clements. Construction work is expected to start this summer.

San Pedro theater for Warner Brothers to cost \$250,000. Plans are being prepared by Marcus Priteca and construction work will begin shortly.

Pantages theater in Hollywood practically completed at a cost of \$750,000. Marcus Priteca, architect.

Fox West Coast Theater in Pomona to cost \$250,000. Balch and Stanbery, architects. Work to begin during the summer.

Wilshire and Beverly Drive theater for Fox West Coast Theaters to cost \$250,000. Scheduled for construction this summer; Balch and Stanbery architects.

Huntington Park theater for Fox West Coast to cost \$300,000; work scheduled for this summer. Balch and Stanbery architects.

Fox West Coast Whittier theater to cost \$150,000. Soon to be started on South Greenleaf avenue. Plans prepared by David S. Bushnell, engineer.

Fox theater, Wilshire Boulevard and Hamilton, Beverly Hills, under construction at a cost of \$300,000. S. Charles Lee architect.
